# THE FACTS & FIGURES

- The Convention Centre Dublin can host events for up to 8,000 delegates. It includes a 2,000-seat auditorium.
- To date, The CCD has secured 150 events, which will result in a boost of over €110m<sup>[1]</sup> in economic benefit for Dublin.
- The average delegate spend is €1,500.<sup>[1]</sup>
- PricewaterhouseCoopers (PWC) and Fortis Bank head offices are located in Spencer Dock. Nationwide UK (Ireland) and The Central Bank & Financial Services Authority also occupy office buildings in Spencer Dock.
- Over 2,400 people employed in Spencer Dock.
- Approx. 13,000 people living within 15 minute walk time.
- High spending age group (25-44 yrs) represents 39% of population within 15 minute walk time.

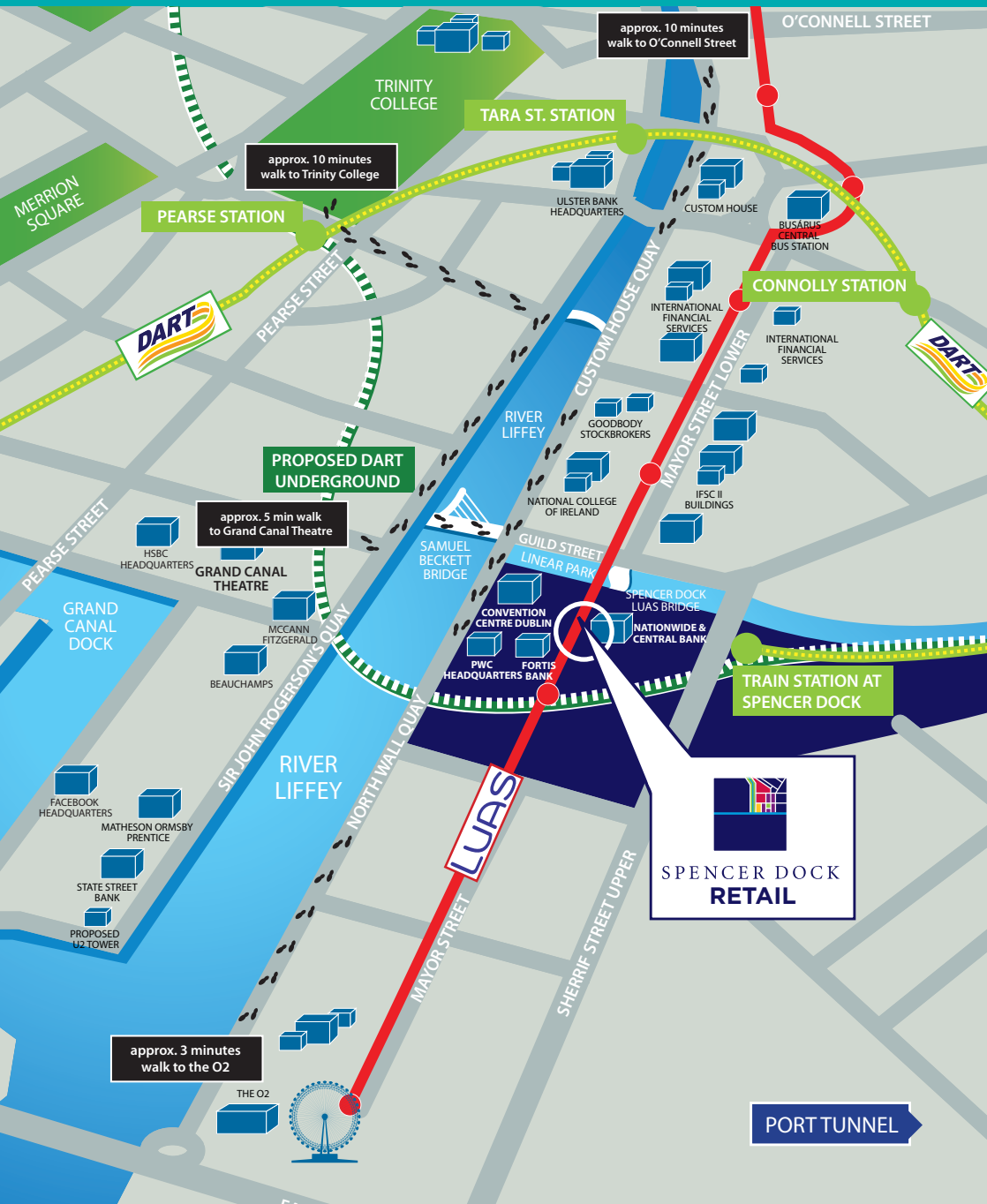


Rail Station at Spencer Dock

Spencer Dock has an unrivalled level of public transport immediately available. The Docklands train station is on the doorstep carrying 5,000 passengers per week. In addition the Spencer Dock LUAS stop opened in December 2009, the extended red line will carry 5,000 passengers per hour.

The landmark Spencer Dock LUAS Bridge carries the LUAS across the Royal Canal stopping at Spencer Dock and continuing along Mayor Street to the O2. The Spencer Dock LUAS bridge is now open to vehicles, cyclists and pedestrians.

The spectacular Samuel Beckett bridge provides further links from Dublin's south side to Spencer Dock.

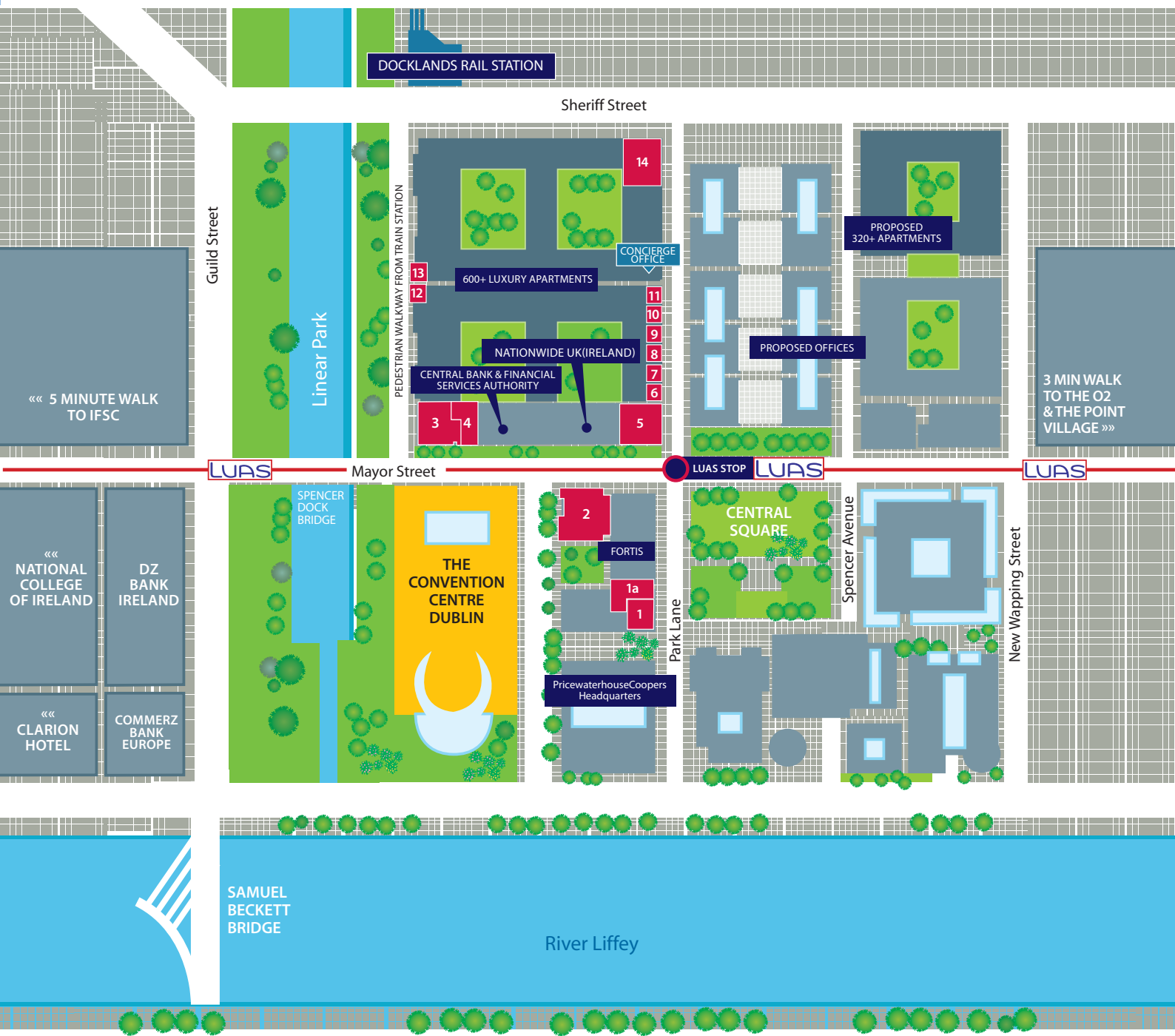
